The Early Years of Cane Creek...

Cane Creek Baptist Church was established in August of 1789 when nine settlers came together as trustees to buy an acre of land for a meeting house. That first meeting house was a rough and drafty log building about 25 feet wide by 35 feet long and sat on a hill overlooking Cane Creek.

Our first pastor was Thomas Cate, a local resident, who first associated himself with the Haw River Church near Bynum and who probably was baptized by their pastor, Elnathen Davis. Although our meeting house was built in 1789 by a Baptist, the congregation did not affiliate with other Baptists until 1807. In 1807, Cane Creek and extensions church at Haw River Mountain, now Antioch, cast their lot with the Sandy Creek Association.

Our earliest records were destroyed by a fire in 1829 but we know that in 1816, the Cane Creek congregation numbered 45. It is estimated that this group consisted of 10 men, 26 women, and 9 slaves. In addition to Antioch, Cane Creek has helped to start other churches in the area (Mars Hill, Crossroads, Moore's Chapel, and Hickory Grove).

The first church building was located within 400 feet of Cane Creek on land now owned by the Perry family. In 1853 the congregation bought the present track of land and built its third church house. The present church building was built in 1949-1950 with the Educational Building being added shortly thereafter. The parsonage was built in 1970.
